Your special report (How the mobile phone changed the world, G2, November 11) said little about the two areas that perhaps have the most to gain from 3G technology - the pornography and gambling industries.

As with most forms of technological innovation, it is those industries that have most to gain financially from their customers who will exploit it. Unfortunately, by providing such services direct to mobile phone users, there is little to protect vulnerable populations (eg, adolescents, problem gamblers, the intoxicated) and at present there is little in the legislation to prevent it.
